FUN RECIPES FROM ABROAD!

Biscotti (Italy)



Ingredients

- 6 eggs
- 2 cups sugar
- 1 cup butter
- 1/4 tsp. salt
- 2 tsp. baking power
- 4 tsp. almond extract
- 2 cups chopped almonds (optional)
- 4 cups flour (or enough until the dough is thick)

Method

1. Mix all the ingredients, except the flour, together with a cake mixer
2. Gradually add and blend in the flour. Add enough until the dough is thick (may need to add an additional cup of flour).
3. Shape into 2 long loaves (approximately 17x5 inches) about an inch high on long cookie sheet.
4. Sprinkle sugar on top of the loaves.
5. Bake at 350 degrees for 15-20 minutes until golden brown on the top.
6. Let cool for 10 minutes.
7. Slice in 1/2 inch thick slices and place back on the cookie sheet on sliced sides.
8. Bake at 375 degrees to lightly brown both sides.
9. Remember to flip to brown both sides.
