Chichen-Itza— This site is a former city built by the Mayan population. The pyramid-like building and temples are frequently visited by tourists and archaeologists. The main temple, called Temple of Kukulkan, is in the center of the city and features stairs on all four sides of the pyramid that visitors can walk up.
